Schedules

As we try to accommodate the requests from different teams, there likely will be changes after they are published and these may continue up until the event. Make sure to check the website frequently for any changes.

Medical Release

Every player is required to have a medical release form signed by a parent to be shown at registration.

- You may bring your own from your club.
- You may use ours (<u>click here</u>).
- You must sign the "Team Medical Release" form to leave at registration and have your individual forms with you at each game.

Registration

Registration will be held at Parma Town Park on **Friday, June 7**th **from 5:00 – 8:30pm and Saturday, June 8**th **from 7:00am – 12:00pm**. Team Check-In is required between these hours and no later than one hour prior to your first game at the tournament headquarters. You will need the following items:

- Official Team Roster please review the maximum roster size for your age group.
- Player & Coaches passes (including <u>guest players' forms</u>). If you have guest players you MUST print this form and bring it with you along with their original player pass.
- Team medical release form
- Signed Acknowledgement Form of Tournament Rules

Please note that individual game cards/game rosters are NOT required for this event. There is no check-in with the referee prior to each individual match. You are however subject to an individual game audit as per our Tournament Rules, so keep player cards/books with you at all times. You must also have your player medical forms accessible if needed.

Youth Clinic

We are offering a youth clinic for Boys & Girls ages U6-U8 run by Nino Pilato and Jamie Schneider. This is a great opportunity for families who have younger members interested in soccer that would like an opportunity to participate in the tournament. The youth clinic will be held on Saturday evening.

Coaches Game

The 3rd Annual Coaches game will be held on Saturday night immediately following our youth clinic. COME CHEER on your coaches as they play a game against their opposing coaches. There will be prize drawings, giveaways, and a 50/50 raffle.

Sportsmanship

Please remember that in the spirit of good sportsmanship and to provide the best tournament experience for all teams, we have instituted a **maximum goal differential of three (3)** to be used only when necessary to break ties in the standings. It makes no difference if you win 6-0 or 3-0. It will be recorded the same either way. Please keep this in mind during your matches. There will be a Sportsmanship award to be handed out at all pool play games to the player on the other team that you felt exemplified the best sportsmanship in the game.

Award Presentations: U11-U19

We have <u>Champions **and** Finalist</u> awards for teams in all divisions. After your Championship match, please proceed to our registration tent area where a Tournament Official will greet you and direct you through our presentation.

Participation Awards: U9 and U10

For our U9 and U10's, **every** player on **every** team gets a participation award.

Check Results/Standings

Our scores will be updated throughout the day on the GotSoccer website. The GotSoccer website offers the ability to register for notifications of score updates if you are interested. It is very important that you visit our website Saturday evening for informational updates, should there be any. Also, if you are in a 6-team division, then you will need to check and see what time and what field your first Sunday match is on. We will not be calling you to tell you when/where to go. It is your responsibility to inform your team.

Inclement Weather

Should we need to temporarily halt our event due to inclement weather, we will simultaneously inform all of our Field Marshalls, who will then attempt to immediately get the attention of the Field Referees. The event will restart, as per our tournament rules, after consultation between the event Head Referee and the Tournament Committee.

What if I have a problem at the event?

Go to the registration tent and ask for a Tournament Official, or get the attention of one of our Field Marshalls located throughout the facility. They will have radios and should be able to get help quickly in an emergency.
